Universities across the globe are by nature knowledge production and distribution hubs. The repository is a vehicle for opening up TUT's knowledge production and distribution system to the world. It operationalises the policy on TUT's own institutional repository.

The new system has been customised and is harvested on Google. The harvesting ensures greater visibility of the University's research outputs across the world and thus exposes the research work of our researchers and postgraduate students.
