



Admission requirements

A National Diploma or an equivalent qualification and admission is subject to evaluation by a panel.

Preference will be given to applicants who are working in a project environment.

Duration

One year. Evening classes only.

Block - based classes offered over a period of eighteen months. Prospective students may register for a maximum of three subjects in each semester.

(The Department recommends doing the qualification over two years)

Advise management on projects (e.g. project prioritisation and selection), manage and/or administrate projects from initiation to final closure, facilitate the project management process, execute feasibility studies, facilitate and execute detailed project planning and re-planning, execute and implement project quality assurance and control, optimise project resources, apply risk management, facilitate project procurement, administer and control project resources, implement project management principles, policies and procedures.
