



## Introduction

This programme has been developed and adapted according to the changing needs of tourism and focuses strongly on management, marketing and entrepreneurship. By means of interpretation and transfer, modern technology is accessed and made useful to students and the tourism industry.

The Department of Tourism Management at TUT strives to offer the best tourism education in South Africa and to provide students with affordable and relevant entrepreneurial training. The importance of maintaining an environment in which international and domestic tourism will prosper is impressed on students during their studies. Included in the training are a third language (French, German, Spanish), possible international experiential learning, industry practice, Galileo, Fidelio, Quicktrav and Summit.

## Admission requirements

### Minimum academic requirements

In addition to the National Senior Certificate (general or vocational), with a minimum of 6 subjects, a candidate must meet the following specific requirements for this programme:

### Specific subject requirements

- A minimum mark of 3 in English (first or additional language)
- A minimum mark of 3 in any other 4 recognised NSC 20-credits subjects, excluding Life Orientation.

### Recommended subjects

- Human and Social Studies (Geography, History)
- Service (Hospitality Studies, Tourism)
- Business, Commerce and Management Studies (Accounting, Business Studies, Economics)
- Physical, Mathematical, Computer and Life Sciences (Computer Applications Technology, Life Science)
- Mathematics or Mathematical Literacy
- Any second language or additional subjects

## Assessment procedure

- Applicants with a final APS score of 50 and more, according to the formula, will be accepted and will receive a letter to confirm their admission.
- Acceptance is subject to available capacity according to the Student Enrolment Plan (SEP).
- Applicants with a score between 48 and 49 will be invited to do the TUT-Potential Assessment (PA) test.

## Duration

Three years of full-time study (day classes only).

## Career description

On completing the qualification, a tourism practitioner will be able to do the following in a professional manner: Provide information and advice concerning destinations, handle all travel arrangements, and market destinations and professional services profitably.

## Career opportunities

Career opportunities depend on your interest and could be: travel agents (retail); tour operators (inbound and outbound); incentive travel; meeting and convention planning; airlines (reservation fares, marketing, etc.); car-rental (reservations, marketing sales, etc.); cruise lines (reservations, administration, marketing, etc.); guest services (accommodation, recreation, sightseeing tours, etc.); tourism information services; man-made attractions (guiding and administration); education and training; and various opportunities for the entrepreneur.
