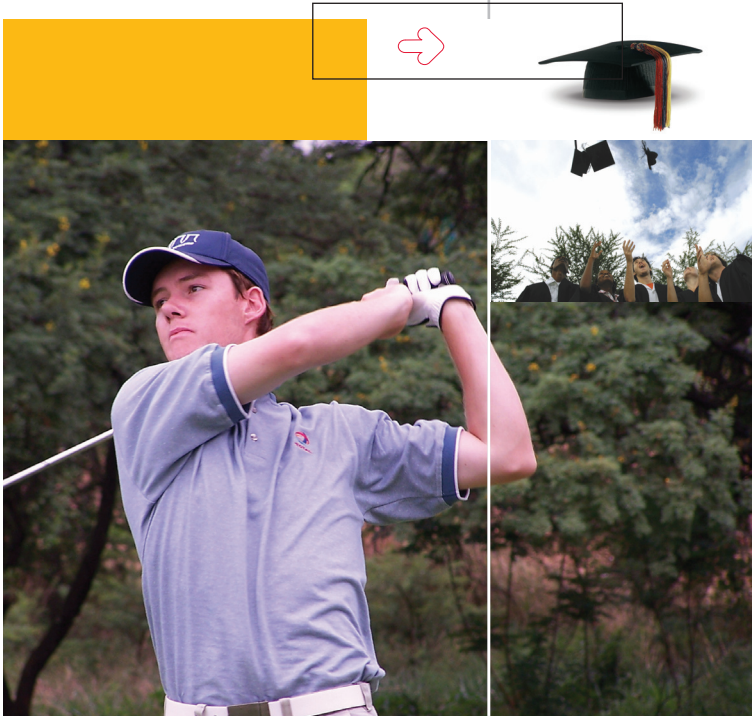

Duration of the course

Successful candidates will enroll for a Bachelors degree (BTech) in either Sport Management or Officiating & Coaching in conjunction with the PGA Diploma: Club Professional Golfing. The duration for the BTech degree is a minimum of 4 years and the PGA Diploma is 3 years. Candidates will enroll for the two qualifications simultaneously. Classes are presented as day classes on a full time basis
