### REMARKS

- a. *Admission requirement(s):*  
A Baccalaureus Technologiae: Food and beverage Management or a qualification at NQF Level 7 (old) or NQF Level 8 (new) in the field of food and beverage studies. A candidate must have passed Research Methodology at NQF Level 7 before registration or must pass Research Methodology in the first year of study if it was not included in a previous qualification.
- b. *Selection criteria:*  
Selection is based on a personal interview with the departmental selection panel. Registration prior to the approval of a protocol is provisional and will be made official only if the protocol is approved by the Faculty Committee for Postgraduate Studies. These procedures will be fully explained to prospective students during their personal interviews.
- c. *Duration:*  
A minimum of one year and a maximum of three years.
- d. *Presentation:*  
Research.
- e. *Intake for the qualification:*  
January and July.
- f. *Rules on postgraduate studies:*  
See Chapter 8 of Students' Rules and Regulations.
- g. *Subject credits:*  
Subject credits are shown in brackets after each subject.
