## REMARKS

a. *Admission requirement(s):*

A Baccalaureus Technologiae: Construction Management or Quantity Surveying or a NQF Level 8 Bachelor or Honours in Construction Management or Quantity Surveying (or related field), with an aggregate of 60% for the final-year of study, obtained from an accredited South African university.

Candidates with a baccalaureus technologiae, will be required to complete bridging modules: Engineering Data Analyses, Life Cycle Management and Supply Chain Management, (or their equivalents) at NQF Level 8. Candidates who have not completed these bridging modules before registration, will be required to complete them concurrently with this qualification.

Holders of any other equivalent South African or international qualification may also be considered, see Chapter 1 of Students' Rules and Regulations.

b. *Selection criteria:*

Admission will be subject to approval of a research topic by the Departmental Research Committee (DRC). Candidates who do not meet the 60% minimum academic requirements, will be invited to a Departmental Selection Committee for consideration.

c. *Duration:*

A minimum of one year and a maximum of three years.

d. *Presentation:*

Research.

e. *Intake for the qualification:*

January and July.

f. *Rules on postgraduate studies:*

g. *Module credits:*
