

# GENERAL FACULTY RULES

At the Faculty of ICT the following rules apply:

1. A student may repeat any subject offered in any of the qualifications at the Faculty of Information and Communication Technology only twice.
2. Students must complete all subjects before registering for Industry Exposure IIIB (this is not applicable to phasing-out programmes). Students with only one subject outstanding may be allowed to register for Industry Exposure IIIB, with the approval of the Head of Department.
3. A student must complete a qualification at the learning site where he/she was accepted and is registered. A transfer between sites will only be considered if the student follows the following process: A formal request must be submitted to the Academic manager/Head of the Department on the current learning site by the second Friday in October (to be considered for a transfer in January of the following year). The request must contain the reasons for the transfer.
4. Access to a laptop or desktop computer is essential to participate in multimodal learning experiences as well as to complete assignments and projects. NSFAS students receive an allowance to acquire a laptop, and using this allowance for this purpose is critical for academic success. Students are encouraged to consult the faculty website where the minimum requirements for specific programmes are published.
