The Tshwane University of Technology's Centre for Creative Industries at its Faculty of Arts and Design now offers Short Learning Programmes (SLPs) in Batik, Tie and Dye Techniques; Fundamentals of Dressmaking/Sewing Skills; Entrepreneurship in the Arts; and Footwear Design.

The Batik, Tie and Dye Techniques programme is designed to equip you with practical training experience and an understanding of entrepreneurship in preparation for the establishment of Batik, Tie and Dye Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs).

Our Fundamentals of Dressmaking/Sewing Skills programme will equip you with basic skills to become a tailor. During this SLP, you will be introduced to garment and pattern construction principles and techniques, through practical application.

The Entrepreneurship in the Arts programme aims to equip you for entrepreneurial and management responsibilities in a small arts, cultural, or creative business. It will show you how to apply marketing concepts and principles relating to product, pricing, promotion, and distribution strategies in business.

You will also be guided in managing the operations of the business ethically, efficiently, and effectively with regards to human resources, production, and operations management. In addition, the programme has a strong focus on managing finances and assets, and evaluating the financial performance of a small arts, cultural, or creative business.

Our Footwear Design programme is designed to empower you with a working knowledge about the footwear industry, including pattern design and manufacturing theory about footwear.
