

## 2026/2027 TUT POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS CALL

The Tshwane University of Technology invites suitable applications for the position of Postdoctoral Research Fellow in the Department of Applied Languages, Faculty of Humanities.

### **Research field/area:**

- Aviation Linguistics, Computational Linguistics, English Language Studies, Forensic Linguistics, General Linguistics, Language in Education, Language in Planning and Policy, Literature, Sociolinguistics, Translation or Interpreting, and Terminology Development and Lexicography.

### **Minimum requirements:**

- Doctoral degree in Language Practice, African Languages, Linguistics, Translation Studies, English Language Studies, Language Education, or an equivalent qualification.
- The degree must have been obtained within five (5) years of applying (a degree awarded in 2024, 2025, and 2026 will receive preference).
- Applicants must have authored/co-authored at least two research outputs since the start of their doctoral studies.

### **Value of fellowship:**

- R250,000 per annum.
- A R50,000 incentive bonus would be paid to Postdoctoral Research Fellows who exceeded the research outputs requirements annually.
