- Prepare episode outlines, questions, and talking points aligned to institutional values and institutional goals
- Facilitate inclusive, respectful, and engaging discussions on student-related themes.
- Collaborate with students clubs and societies to identify relevant content and voices
- Support students participation and skills development in podcasting, media, and digital communication
- Coordinate recording schedules and ensure timely release of episodes
- Promote Podcast through campus platforms and social media channels
- Ensure content complies with university policies, ethics, and communication standards
- Responsible for booking of guests
- Liaising with guests and other team members to ensure timely delivery of content
- Assist in developing and managing podcast marketing strategies to increase audience engagement and growth
- Collaborate with internal and external partners to create engaging and relevant content for the podcast
- Assist in overseeing all aspects of a Podcast's production, ranging from technical to administrative tasks
- Monitor and analyse podcast performance metrics to identify areas for improvement and growth
