You are hereby invited to participate in the ETDP-SETA INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME for Tshwane University of Technology. The purpose of the project is to provide temporary employment opportunities for young graduates from Public University who have not been able to find employment. Where possible graduates will be placed in Pretoria Campus subject to the needs of departments.

Failure to comply with this instruction will disqualify the candidate. Candidates may be subjected to appropriate psychometric testing and other selection instruments.

- To provide and implement Employee Health and Wellness intervention strategies so as to improve the psycho-social wellbeing and work performance of the individual, as well as build on organisation effectiveness of Tshwane University of Technology.

- To support core administration and operation where additional support is required on a temporary basis.
- To support workplace experience for unemployed graduates.

- Certified copy of South African identity document (this opportunity is only available to South African Citizens and permanent residents)

- You must be a graduate from any South African University.
- You must be unemployed and not benefited from any SETA/DHET project previously.
