- Coaching in USSA/Super League/ Provincial/Competitions will be an added advantage.
- Proficiency in English.
- Computer Literacy.
- Basic first aid qualification level 1 or 2.
- Code 8 or 10 Driver's license.
- No criminal record.
- Police clearance
- Safe-guarding certificate

Duties:

- To coach the TUT Mbombela Netball Team in the Leagues, Super League and other related competitions.
- Planning, organizing and executing practice sessions according to the needs and demands of the team.
- Plan and organize trials for talent identification and recruitment of new players to the club.
- Promoting fair play.
- Resolving team issues and mentoring players.
- Be an example to the other technical team members and players to provide a positive atmosphere.
- Provide reports on development of players, matches, etc.

- Be responsible for assessing the performance of the players under your expert direction.

- Oversee developing tactics and training activities.

- Thorough knowledge of Netball structures and policies of NSA, comply with the NSA Coaches Code of Behavior, Ability to work under pressure.
