Beware of scammers promising to assist you with a study or res space in exchange for money!

Any communication (SMS, email, letter, WhatsApp, social media post) bearing TUT branding that requests payment before official acceptance is **fraudulent**. **Do not respond to such messages. Delete it immediately.**

TUT **does not** have any third-party agents to assist students with admission.

TUT **does not** post official letters promising to assist with applications, application status or placement on WhatsApp, Facebook, TikTok, LinkedIn or other social media platforms, or on **unofficial** websites.

TUT **does not** offer a 24/7 service via cellphone or WhatsApp numbers.

TUT **does not** charge money to assist you with your application. The only charge is a **R240 application fee**.

TUT **does not** guarantee programme or residence space for a fee.

Academic places, residence allocation, and bursaries are **strictly merit- and needs-based**.

Promises to “reverse a rejection” or “upgrade your status” for a fee are criminal extortion – official appeals are free and follow published procedures only.
