UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES DIPLOMA IN INFORMATICS

- **About the Diploma in Informatics:**

Informatics is a field of study that explores the interplay between technology, business and society. It utilizes information management tools for the processing, management, and analysis of data that relates to business. Graduates in the field of Informatics serve as a bridge between the developers and the users of the technology and global innovations.

- **Admission requirements**

For mainstream programme (3 years):

Level **4** for English (home language or first additional language) and **5** for Mathematics or Technical Mathematics or **7** for Mathematical Literacy.

To be considered for this qualification, applicants must have an Admission Point Score (APS) of at least **26** (with Mathematics) or **28** (with Mathematical Literacy).

For extended programme (4 years):

Level **3** for English (home language or first additional language) and **4** for Mathematics or Technical Mathematics or **6** for Mathematical Literacy.

Applicants with a score of **23** (with Mathematics) or **25** (with Mathematical Literacy) will be considered for the extended programme.
