ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: National Senior Certificate with a Bachelor's degree or diploma endorsement or an equivalent qualification.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: National Certificate Vocational at NQF level 4
 A National Certificate (Vocational) with a bachelor's degree or a diploma endorsement, with at least 50% for English (home language or first additional language) and 40% for Mathematics or Mathematical Literacy, 40% for Life Orientation (excluded for APS calculation), 50% for any other three compulsory vocational subjects.

Selection criteria: APS=25 (excl. Life Orientation)

The certificate must be in any of the following fields: accounting, computer science, economics, finance, hospitality, information technology, management, marketing, office administration or tourism.

MINIMUM DURATION: Three years.

 The Diploma in Casino Resort Management will enable students to be fully trained in all aspects required in running, managing or working at a fully functional casino. You will be familiarised and obtain an understanding of the total structure and functioning of a casino resort.
