



Parent & Child Modules in myTUTOR

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Modules with the same content and/or different module codes can be linked to enable you as a lecturer or group of lecturers, to upload your content into **one module** on *myTUTOR*. This approach of linking modules is advisable when there is more than one lecturer teaching the same module to cohorts on different campuses or in different timeslots i.e., an evening class and a morning class of the same course. Lecturers can still make module content, assessments and announcements relevant to only their cohort of students by using the Release Conditions functionality.

Q: How are Parent and Child modules created?

A: A Parent and Child Module relationship is set up by the *myTUTOR* Service Desk on *myTUTOR* in the following way:

- Identify the Parent module code.
- List the modules (Child modules) that should be linked to the Parent module code.
- Request the *myTUTOR* Service Desk to link the modules.
- Students are managed in Sections in *myTUTOR* (derived from the ITS Class Groups).
- There must be students registered in all the modules for the merge to be successful.

NOTE: Students will no longer see their registered module code (Child Module code). Departments should communicate this to students.
